In July 2013, an unknown suspect fraudulently obtained a store branded MasterCard by impersonating a resident of Markham. On three different occasions on July 19, 20 and 21 the suspect attended three different Toronto Dominion bank branches and obtained cash from their ATM's using the fraudulent credit card.

THE SUSPECT IS DESCRIBED AS:

- Male, black, 25-35 years, shaved hair.
