On Friday, September 30, 2016, at approximately 2:11 p.m., two unknown suspects entered the Scotiabank located on Steeles Avenue West in the City of Vaughan. The female suspect attempted to open an account using a fraudulent age of majority card. The bank employee became suspicious about the card's authenticity and informed the two suspects that the account will not be processed. The female suspect grabbed the fraudulent card back from the employee and both suspects then exited the bank in an unknown direction of travel.

Male, black, 6'0", 190 lbs, 20-30 years of age, medium build, medium complexion, short black hair, beard, glasses, wearing a green sweater with zipper on sleeve and jeans.
