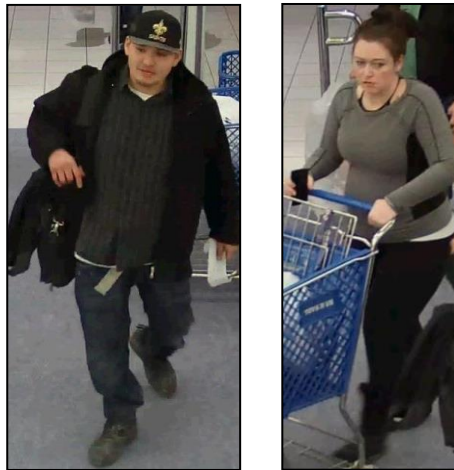

On Wednesday, January 17, 2018, at approximately 4:06 p.m., two unknown suspects attended the Toys 'R' Us store located on Yonge Street in the Town of Newmarket. The female suspect proceeded to select a Skip Hop Suite Diaper tote bag and placed it inside the store bag provided by the male suspect. Both suspects attended to the customer service desk, requested an exchange of the item for a gift card but were denied because they were unable to provide either a receipt or identification. They then left the store and made no attempt to pay for the stolen item.

THE SUSPECTS ARE DESCRIBED AS:

- Male, Hispanic, 30 years old, 6'0", 220 lbs, short black hair, goatee, wearing a black baseball cap with a New Orleans Saints logo, black jacket, blue pants, black running shoes and carrying a black bag;
- Female, white, 30 years old, 5'7", 140 lbs, dark brown hair tied into bun, wearing a grey sweater, green jacket, black tights, black winter boots and carrying a green diaper bag.
